The Queensland Trucking Association Ltd conducts its service to members in relation to obligations under the Fair Work Act and the framework of the nation's Modern Award system through our registered Union of Employers, the Australian Road Transport Industrial Organisation (ARTIO).

In late 2009, ARTIO presented to the road freight/trucking industry the “Fair Work Education Program”.

ARTIO have again been successful in being awarded funding by the Fair Work Ombudsman for the “Shared Industry Assistance Projects (SIAP)”.

SIAP will assist and fund ARTIO, to build upon the previous information and education campaign. The seminar, detailed below and open to Association members and non-members will provide a detailed briefing on the transition to the Modern Awards “Road Transport & Distribution Award 2010” and the “Road Transport (Long Distance Operations) Award 2010”, as well as addressing the National Employment Standards (NES).

All attendees will be provided free of charge a detailed Explanatory Handbook, compiled by ARTIO, in relation to both Awards. The Handbook is designed to assist employers in understanding their obligations and applying the relevant Award provisions in the workplace.
