

## WASTE MANAGEMENT AWARD 2010 – VWMA PAY RATES SCHEDULE 1 JULY 2018

This Modern Award is applicable to employers working in the waste management industry.

Rates are current from the first pay period commencing on or after 1 July 2018. Issued: 26 June 2018

Note: The industry allowance of \$92.00 is payable for all purposes and has been added to the minimum rate of pay as set out below. That rate is divided by 38 to obtain the hourly rate which is used for all purposes, including overtime for both permanent and casual employees

Driver of Road Sweeper  
Furnace Operator  
Incinerator Operator  
Operator of earthmoving plant up to and including 150 BHP  
Trainee driver of a vehicle exceeding 14t GVM  
Driver of a waste management vehicle between 4.5 and 14t GVM**

**5. Driver of vehicle exceeding 14 tonnes GVM and up to 30 tonnes GVM, being:**  
- rear end loading vehicles  
- roll on/roll off vehicles  
- side lift vehicles  
- liquid waste rigid vehicles  
- lift on skip or morrell vehicles  
- pantehnicon  
- vehicle carrying septic tanks, chemical closets, portaloos etc

### CASUALS

Casual employees receive an allowance of 25% on the hourly rate (see Note above) of pay for all **ordinary hours** worked -see definition below. **For overtime hours, the 25% allowance is reduced to 10% of the hourly rate of pay.**  
A casual must be paid a minimum of 4 hours per start

### ALLOWANCES

- Meal Allowance **\$16.24**
- Transport Allowance – start before 4am **\$8.28**
- First Aid Allowance **\$4.18** per day
- Leading Hand weekly allowance
  - 4-8 employees **\$22.59**
  - 9-15 employees **\$33.46**
  - >15 employees **\$46.00**

**ORDINARY HOURS & OVERTIME** – the spread of ordinary hours under this award is **4.00am to 5.00pm**, Monday to Friday. Any work outside those hours, or beyond 7.6 per day (or 8 if accruing for an RDO) should be paid at overtime rates, **time and a half for the first 2 hours and double time thereafter.**  
**NB: the casual loading reduces from 25% to 10% of the base rate above on overtime hours.**

**Waste Management Award 2010 - Rates as at 1 July 2018**

Industry Allowance (IA) is \$92.00 is added to the Minimum Weekly rate and divided by 38 to give hourly rate. Note IA is included in casual hourly rate
