# RATES OF PAY FOR EASTER, ANZAC, LABOUR DAY & QUEEN'S BIRTHDAY PUBLIC HOLIDAYS 2011



### RARE FIVE DAY LONG WEEKEND FOR QUEENSLAND WORKERS IN 2011

The following is an extract from a Media Statement by Queensland Attorney-General and Minister for Industrial Relations, The Hon Cameron Dick MP

Queensland workers will enjoy a rare five-day long weekend next Easter as the result of a once-in-ageneration clash of dates.

Industrial Relations Minister Cameron Dick said for the first time since Queensland's public holiday laws were introduced in 1983, Easter Monday and Anzac Day would clash in 2011.

"As a result of this coincidence, the government has decided to appoint Tuesday, 26th April 2011, as a substitute public holiday for Easter Monday," Mr Dick said.

"This decision will not result in an extra public holiday - it is merely transferring a public holiday that workers are entitled to, to the following day.

"Both Easter Monday and Anzac Day are public holidays under our laws and after extensive consultation with stakeholders, we have decided to transfer the Easter Monday holiday.

"This decision means that employees working on either the 25th or 26th of April next year, or both, will get public holiday penalty rates according to their relevant award or agreement.

"These days represent two of the most significant religious and national events on our calendar and the government firmly believes that the community should have the opportunity to celebrate both.

Mr Dick said that as a result of the decision, the Anzac Day public holiday would remain on 25th April 2011.

"The limitations on business operations that usually occur on Anzac Day because of its special nature will continue to apply on 25th April next year."

Oueensland public holidays for the Easter period in 2011 will be observed on Good Friday (22nd April) Easter Saturday (23rd April), Anzac Day (Monday, 25th April) and a substitute public holiday for Easter Monday on Tuesday, 26th April 2011.

- > Easter Saturday Saturday 23rd April 2011
- Anzac Day Monday 25th April 2011
- Easter Monday Tuesday 26th April 2011
- ➤ Labour Day Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> May 2011 (Queensland)
- Queen's Birthday Monday 13th June 2011

Below is a chart which applies Award conditions to specific days and explains the rate of pay for all work performed on each such Public Holiday. **In all cases, the minimum payment shall be for 4 hours work.** 

#### **Further Notes:**

- (a) Any employee who is absent on the day prior to, or the day after a public holiday (without reasonable cause), is not entitled to payment for the public holiday(s) under any of the new modern awards.
- **(b)** Employees are only entitled to be absent from work and paid for such day if ordinarily required to work on that day.
- (c) Easter Sunday is not classified as a Public Holiday and will attract the normal Sunday rates.

	Easter Monday, Anzac Day, Labour Day (Old) & Queen's Birthday  Time and a Half for first 8 hours (plus normal day's pay)  Overtime – Double time & a half
	Casuals: Double Time and a Half (plus loading – 10% of ordinary time)
	Easter Saturday Double Time and a Half (Public Holiday outside the Spread of Hours)
	Casuals: Double Time and a Half (plus loading – 10% of ordinary time)

	As per normal Sunday rates

	Easter Saturday 150% of relevant hourly rate
	Casuals: 275% of relevant hourly rate

CLERKS – PRIVATE SECTOR  AWARD 2010	For work by any employee – casual or permanent - on any public holiday payment must be at double time and a half with a minimum of 4 hours payment.
	Easter Sunday
	As per normal Sunday rates
ROAD TRANSPORT (LONG DISTANCE OPERATIONS) AWARD 2010	Good Friday 30% of the applicable minimum weekly base rate <u>plus</u> payment at the applicable CPK or hourly rate for the days worked.
	(Example – Grade 4 (semi) is 30% of the Award weekly rate - $$653.40 \times 30\% = $196.02 \text{ plus}$ payment at the CPK or hourly rate for the day.)
	Casuals: 30% of the applicable minimum rate <u>plus</u> payment at the CPK or hourly rate for the day.
	Easter Saturday, Easter Monday, Anzac Day, Labour Day (Old) & Queen's Birthday  20% of the applicable minimum rate plus payment at the CPK or hourly rate for the days worked.
	(Example – Grade 4 (semi) is 20% of the Award weekly rate - $$653.40 \times 20\% = $130.68 \text{ plus}$ payment at the CPK or hourly rate for the day.)
	Casuals:
	20% of the applicable minimum weekly base rate <u>plus</u> payment at the applicable CPK or hourly rate for the days worked.
	For a permanent employee, <u>not working</u> and entitled to payment for the day:
	A normal day's pay (base weekly rate divided by 5)
	(Example: At grade 4 (semi driver) the holiday payment is the award rate ( $$653.40$ ) divided by $5 = $130.68$ )
