## WASTE MANAGEMENT AWARD 2010 WEEKLY WAGE RATES & ALLOWANCES – July 2012

This award applies to employers engaged in the **Waste Management Industry** as defined in Clause 3 of the Award and operates in all states and territories of Australia from 1 January 2010. <u>These new rates apply from the first pay period commencing on or after 1 July 2012.</u>

NOTE: If you employed workers in NSW prior to 1 January 2010 you may need assistance with the transitional provisions of this Award. If so, please contact your ARTIO Branch listed below.

Minimum rates of pay are detailed below: NB: an industry allowance of \$77.60 is pay all purposes and MUST be added to the rate of pay set out below for each level and divided by 38 to obtain an hourly rate who be used for all purposes, including calculation overtime. For overtime hours, the 25% allowance is reduced to 10% of the minimum rate of pay. In addition, for all hours worked, including overtime, a casual should also receive an extra \$2.04 per hour as a pro-rated industry allowance. A casual must be paid a minimum of 4 hours per start

ORDINARY HOURS & OVERTIME – the spread of ordinary hours under this award is 4.00am to 5.00pm, Monday to Friday. Any work outside those hours, or beyond 7.6 per day (or 8 if accruing for an RDO) should be paid at overtime rates, time and a half for the first 2 hours and double time thereafter. NB: the casual loading reduces from 25% to 10% on overtime hours.
